These fees include external conductors/masterclasses, theory exam, sheet music, ensemble competition fees, equipment servicing/incidental accessories and catering for student/parents at some performance events. Not included is the theory book, optional practical instrumental exam, practical instrumental repertoire book, eisteddfod fees, tours, and excursions.

Selection for the program is determined through an analysis of the following:

- Completed Application form (on the back of this letter)
- Audition on the student's instrument/voice.
- Your child's two most recent semester report cards demonstrating a high level of academic achievement, behaviour and effort.
- Any other supporting documentation such as past music exams.
