

# Positive Behaviour for Learning

Wynnum State High School (Wynnum SHS) is a Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) school. PBL is a whole-school approach to creating a positive, safe and supportive school environment in which all students can learn and thrive. This is achieved by developing systems to define, teach, and support appropriate student behaviours.

Students behave positively in all settings when they know what is expected of them, when they feel safe, and when they know that someone cares about and believes in them and their learning. At a PBL school, all teachers teach and give feedback on expected behaviours.

At Wynnum State High School our **PROUD** values are:

- Positive
- Respectful
- On-task
- Unified
- Determined



These **PROUD** values have been agreed upon and endorsed by our school community and our school P&C.

We expect behaviour in all settings will mirror these expectations; in the classroom, entering and exiting classrooms, in the grounds, on the walkways, at the tuckshop, at the train station and in all public places.

## Positive Behaviour for Learning positive acknowledgement

Students displaying positive behaviours in line with explicitly taught expectations may be eligible for a range of rewards and acknowledgements over the year.

- **PROUD Powercard** – Students can collect stamps from school staff for consistently meeting behaviour expectations. Students can then redeem their stamps at the weekly PROUD Store for a range of rewards, for example tuckshop vouchers, food items, stationary, fidget toys, raffle tickets into draws for discounts on dinner dance or formal tickets etc.
- **PROUD postcard** – Students who demonstrate PROUD behaviours may have a postcard mailed home, to celebrate the positive recognition with their parent/carer.

We believe that our students are PROUD learners and we know that when we follow the PROUD mantra, school is a much more pleasant place to be and allows everyone to meet their full potential.
