This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students meeting the NMS in Reading and numeracy to 95% by 2018
- Increase the percentage of students in the upper 2 Bands in Reading and Numeracy to 20% by 2018
- Achieve 100% QCE for Year 12 students in 2017
- Achieve 80% OP 1 – 15 for eligible year 12 students in 2017
- Improve teacher capability, including both literacy and numeracy skills and pedagogical delivery, through focused coaching and professional development to improve student performance

Our initiatives include

- Develop learning and support plans for students at risk of not meeting NMS
- Continue to implement the Reading to Learn program through Years 7,8 and 9 including the engagement of the Reading Coach
- Professional development targeting school and staff needs as identified by strategic plan and personal development plans
- Developing programs and resources dedicated to improving QCE and OP achievement

Staff release for planning and professional development including Reading to Learn	\$ 60,000
Whole school literacy and numeracy resources	\$ 10,000
Support and extension programs – students at risk and Upper 2 Bands programs	\$ 20,000
Student wellbeing including resources and support personnel	\$ 18,945
Financial support of senior phase of learning	\$ 30,000
