## This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students above National Minimum Standard in Reading to 90% in 2016
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students above National Minimum Standard in Numeracy to 96% in 2016
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students in the upper 2 Bands in Reading to 18% in 2016
- Increase the percentage of Year 9 students in the upper 2 Bands in Numeracy to 20% in 2016
- Achieve 100% QCE for Year 12 students in 2016
- Achieve 80% OP 1 – 15 for eligible year 12 students in 2016

## Our initiatives include

- Develop learning and support plans for students at risk of not meeting National Minimum Standards
- Continue to implement the Reading to Learn program through years 7,8 and 9.
- Continue to fund and support the role of Reading Coach to lead reading improvement
- Build staff capacity through professional development and coaching
- Developing programs and resources dedicated to improving QCE and OP achievement

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Reading to Learn Co-ordinator (wages and additional costs)	\$130,000
Staff training in Reading to Learn	\$ 20,000
Staff release for planning and professional development	\$ 30,000
Support and extension programs – students at risk and Upper 2 Bands programs	\$ 20,000
Resources to support student development	\$ 12,160
Extra staff allocation to support senior students	\$ 30,000
